This Sunday afternoon, after two years of study and reflection (not to mention a weekly drive to Altona), Nick Hass will be commissioned as a Lay Minister of the Diocese of Ogdensburg in a ceremony at St. Mary's Cathedral. We congratulate Nick on successfully completing the diocesan Formation for Ministry program, and we look forward to his ministry here in our parishes! Since the program began in 1990, 30 members from our four parishes have followed this same path and been a considerable blessing to our faith community through their service to the Church. **We need more of you to do the same!** A new cycle of training begins this coming fall, *and will be offered right here in Malone*. It's never been easier to take advantage of this program and get more deeply involved in the life of your parish. The Formation for Ministry program entails weekly classes on topics such as scripture, church history, and morality; occasional workshops on specific areas of parish ministry; and annual retreats to nurture personal spiritual growth. A couple of folks from the Malone Catholic Parishes are already signed up, and several others are now filling out the paperwork. **Why not join them?** As the host community and the largest parish unit in the diocese, we should have the largest representation there!
