## SIGN OF PEACE

The Sign of Peace, an ancient rite of the Church, is intended to prepare us for the reception of Holy Communion. It is not meant to make peace with all in the Church, but rather to be a sign that I have prepared my heart to receive the Lord. It should be extend to one or two next to us when invited. We need not consider it necessary to touch everyone within reach. Simply turn to the one next to you in the pew. It is a valuable ritual of preparation. **We resume the sign of peace today.**

## COMMUNION FROM THE CUP

Each species of communion – the host, the cup – fully are the soul and divinity of Jesus Christ. Receiving from the cup when offered in a fuller expression of the Last Supper and thus the Eucharist. We encourage you do so. Remember there are no studies (and many have been done) which indicate that this ritual causes illness. It is your decision. We hope that many of you will embrace receiving from the "One Cup of the Lord." **We resume this practice today.**
